Update on action 36

JWGBIRD is responsible through Action #36 for establishing collaboration with the leads of other actions on birds, regarding data collection, storage and analysis.

JWGBIRD has included the following recurring annual intersessional task in its 3 year workplan: Respond to requests for advice on Threatened and Declining bird species from ICG-POSH. JWGBIRD aims to provide ad hoc information and advice when requested by ICG-POSH or ICG-POSH action leads.

Progress in 2018:

- 1. JWGBIRD produced a trial assessment of black-legged kittiwake, presented to ICG-POSH 2018 as paper 18/03/03. The trial tests the assessment proforma and to determine the amount of effort required to complete the assessments of each Threatened and Declining species.
- 2. JWGBIRD has been asked by the co-lead (ES) to provide comments on action 43 Promote implementation of the European Commission Species Action Plan for the species (Balearic shearwater and Roseate tern).
